The Christmas tree is a custom brought to America from Germany. Today people set up Christmas trees in their homes. The first trees in the United States were decorated with candy canes and paper ornaments. Today people trim the trees with colorful lights, bulbs, cookies, popcorn, tinsel, and other pretty decorations.

Most Christmas trees today are artificial. People like them because they can use them year after year. Before artificial trees became popular people bought various types of evergreen trees. The most popular evergreen was the fir tree. It would keep its pretty green color and would not shed their needles as quickly as other evergreens.



Many stores, towns and cities decorate trees outdoors for the public to see. The National Christmas Tree in the United States is placed on the South Lawn of the White House. Usually the president or a member of First Family will push the button to light the tree.
