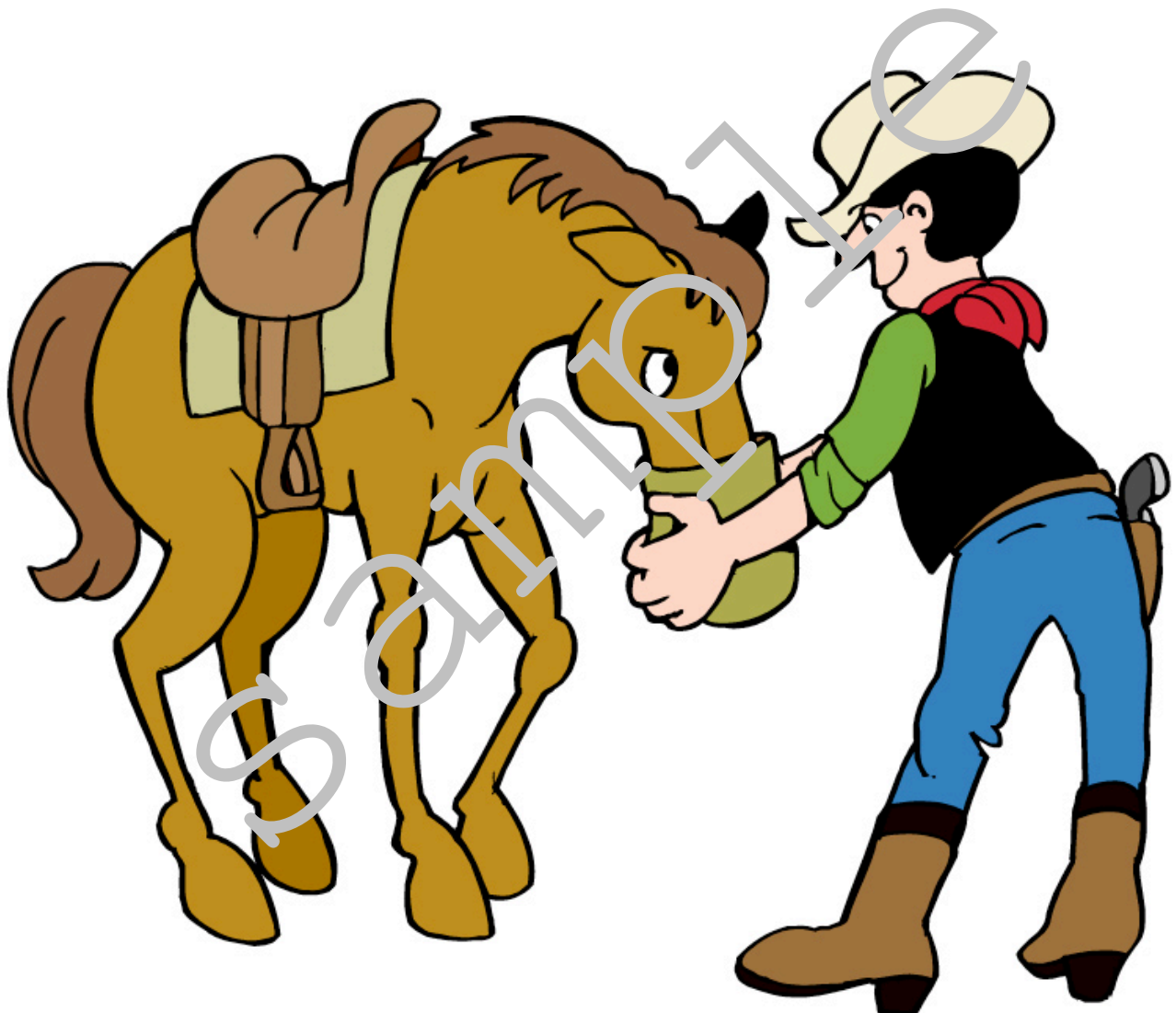

Cowboys Cowgirls

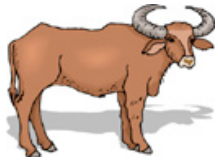


COWGIRLS & COWBOYS

Cowboys and cowgirls are people who tend cattle on ranches in North America. They have many different jobs to do on the ranch.



Traditionally they did most of their work on horseback. Today they use jeeps, pickup trucks, SUV's, and motorcycles on their ranches. Their favorite way to get around the ranch is to ride horses.



They are responsible to feed, brand and care for the cattle on the ranch. They move the cattle to pastures to eat grass and drink water. They mend fences and help injured or sick cattle.

Cowboys and cowgirls need special clothes and equipment to work on their ranches. Some of the western gear include: boots, chaps, bandannas, gloves, jeans, their cowboy hats.

COWGIRLS & COWBOYS

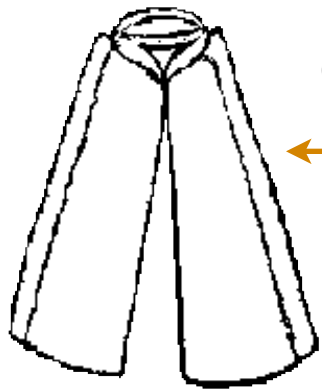
Cowgirls and cowboys usually wear handkerchiefs around their necks. The handkerchief is called a bandanna.



They use bandannas to cover their noses and faces during sandstorms and blizzards.

A cowboy and cowgirl will dip a bandanna into water and put it under their hats to cool off. It can be used as a pot holder and sometimes it will be used as a napkin.

Cowboys and cowgirls wear leather pants. The pants are called chaps. Chaps protect their legs from high bushes, thorns, and the limbs of trees.
